Don Sevilla

Don Sevilla is a Nicaraguan musician and singer-songwriter. He lived for ten years in Mexico City, where he studied composition and singing at the Fermatta Music Academy. He released three albums as a singer and songwriter with the Mexican band Doble Circulación: "Camino sin retorno" (2006), "Suspiro" (2009), and "Dual" (2011), and toured extensively in Mexico and Central America.

In 2013, he launched his first solo album, "A donde sea...", released by Aedón Records in Mexico City. The album featured two videos, "A donde sea" and "Ensayo y error," which were aired on international channels like Telehit and Ritmoson.

In 2018, he was selected by Grammy-winning producer KC Porter (Michael Jackson, Santana, Ricky Martin) and Iker Gastaminza (Shakira, Bacilos, Fonseca) to participate in an international songwriting camp in Guatemala City with composers from Central America and Colombia.

He published his first book as a musical researcher on the music of Nicaragua's Caribbean coast, "Lawana Tiunka," and promoted it with a tour through Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Honduras, and Mexico. In 2024, he was chosen for the U.S. Department of State's Leadership Program, participating in an artistic exchange across more than ten American cities.

Since 2016, he has been a founding member of the Center for Musical Studies in Managua, a music academy and production company that has trained over 1,000 professional musicians in Nicaragua over the past decade.
